## Measuring an existing ring with a caliper (recommended):

1. Choose a ring that fits well the finger of the person who is going to wear it.
2. If you have access to a caliper, use it to get a precise measurement of the inside ring diameter.
3. Use the ring size chart on this page to find the corresponding size.
4. If your ring fits in between two sizes, order the bigger one.

## Measuring an existing ring with the ring size chart:

1. Print this page and make sure that it is $1 / 1$ scale (if you are not sure that you printed this document correctly, measure the 100 mm line at the end of this page and check that it measures exactly 10 cm )
2. Choose a ring that fits well the finger of the person who is going to wear it.
3. Put the ring on the chart and match the inner edge of your ring with the circle that fits closer in size.
4. If your ring fits in between two sizes, order the bigger one.

## Measuring your finger:

Finger size fluctuates depending on temperature. To get a proper measurement follow these recommendations:

1. Measure your finger three to four different times and calculate the average size.
2. Measure your finger at the end of the day: fingers are thinner in the morning and when they are cold.
3. A proper fitting ring should slide over your knuckle with a little friction and fit snugly on your finger, but not too tight. Measure thus your knuckle and the end of your finger and choose a size in between the two measures. Generally, you should order one size bigger than your finger's size.
4. Don't use string or paper to measure your finger, as those are flexible materials and your measured ring finger size may be larger than your finger actually is. If you decide to use string though, try not to force it too taut or any ring you purchase may be too big.

## Ordering a ring without having the size:

If you want to make a gift and you cannot get the size of the ring by any of the previous methods, you can also buy our Gift Card.

If you prefer, you can buy the size that is in stock and send it back yo me within 60 days from receipt so that I can adjust it to the final measurement.
Ring adjustment is free of charge, but you will have to bear the shipping costs.
